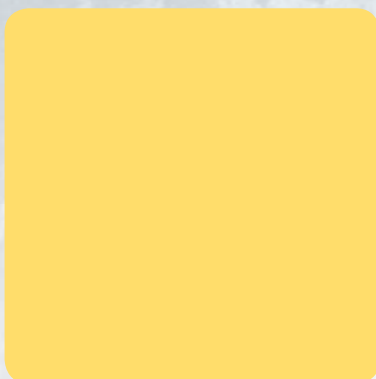
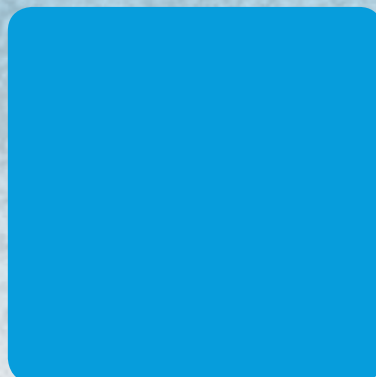

# SHOPPING

Whether you're looking to buy the latest fashions, great souvenirs or just plan a walk through, New York City Shopping is like no other. One of the greatest things about shopping in New York City is that there is a store for nearly everything!

## Canal Street, Chinatown & Little Italy

This unique area offers a wide range of shopping opportunities. On Mott Street, in Chinatown, small specialty stores and street vendors sell their merchandise. Canal Street which divides these two diverse communities, offer a multitude of bargains. From costume jewelry to jeans, the Canal Street motto is "Let's Make a Deal!" Mulberry Street, in the heart of Little Italy, is lined with shops selling Italian delights.

## Century 21

The mother of all discount department stores is Century 21, across Church Street from the World Trade Center site. New inventory flows in literally all day, as do throngs of customers. Despite its often elbow-to-elbow aisles, the store is worth a visit—just aim to go on a weekday morning to take advantage of its bargains before the crowds appear.

## Greenwich Village

Head down to the infamous Greenwich Village area. Historic, landmarked brownstone neighborhood with trendy shops, boutiques, galleries. Home to Washington Square Park and New York University this area is known for being fun and funky!

## Macy's Herald Square

Spend the day exploring Macy's Department Store located in Herald Square, it is one of the last turn-of-the-century department stores in existence. It is also one of NYC's most famous shopping icons, widely recognized for its annual Macy's Thanksgiving Parade.

## Meatpacking District

The Meatpacking District, also known as the Gansevoort Market, has been dubbed New York's most fashionable shopping neighborhood. The area which runs roughly from West 15th Street south to Gansevoort Street, and from the Hudson River east to Hudson Street was historically, as its name suggests, the center of New York City's meatpacking industry. In recent years, it has undergone a transformation and is now home to trendy clothing boutiques like Jeffrey New York, a unique underground mall, cafes, and nightspots catering to a young upscale crowd.

## Rockefeller Center Area

Experience the many sights and sounds of world famous Rockefeller Center and Manhattan's Fifth Avenue. Experience the beauty and glamour of St. Patrick's Cathedral, Radio City Music Hall and Rockefeller Center itself. Don't miss the many shopping opportunities available on Fifth Avenue.

## SoHo

SoHo's shopping grid runs from Broadway west to Sixth Avenue, and Houston Street south to Canal Street. Broadway is the most commercial strip, with big names like Levi's, Hilfiger, Guess, Club Monaco, Bebe, and H&M. Bloomingdale's has a downtown branch on Broadway, while nearby, Prada's flagship store is worth visiting for its spacious, almost soothing design alone. An atypical highlight is the two-story Pearl River Mart Chinese emporium, which offers everything from silk cheongsam (traditional Chinese high-necked dresses) to teaware.

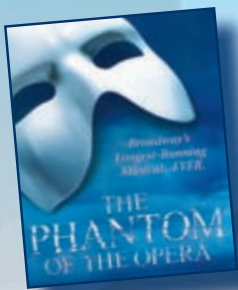
## South Street Seaport
