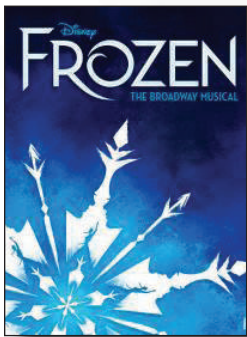
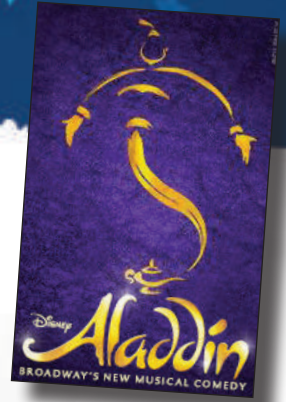

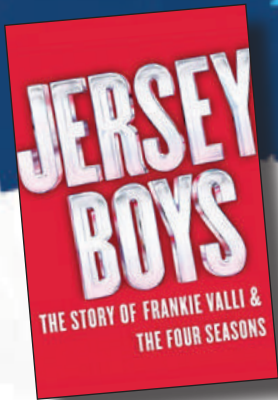

The Business of Show Business (1 Hour)

Students discuss the important details regarding what is needed to plan for a career in the theatre. The guest speaker is chosen by you, from one of the following areas of the showbiz industry: a cast member from one of Broadway's current hits, a member of the creative team of a current show, a leading NYC casting director, a company manager, or a technical director from a current show — the opportunities are endless! This one-hour program provides students with an invaluable “behind-the-scenes peek” of the steps needed to be taken to make a career in professional theatre a reality.

Meet-The-Artist Program (1 Hour)

Students get the rare opportunity to meet with a principal actor from the performance they have seen or will be seeing while on tour. Drama Master Class / Workshop (2 Hours)
